Tuition Assistance Program

Erb Street Mennonite Church highly values Christian education through Sunday School and Mennonite educational institutions. The Tuition Assistance Program provides grants for youth of members/attendees and/or members/attendees of our congregation on a mutual aid basis to further support Mennonite education. While the Tuition Assistance Program is primarily directed to a Mennonite secondary school, our church offers support for post-secondary Mennonite education through a one-time grant.

A tuition grant for students attending Rockway Mennonite Collegiate is usually \$750.00 per student per semester. The Tuition Assistance Program provides a one-time grant of \$750.00 for a student attending a post-secondary Mennonite educational institution (e.g. Goshen, CMU, Grebel (degrees only, not residence)).

This amount is set in the annual church budget. The grants are approved/overseen by council. If, due to special circumstances, a request exceeds the tuition grant amount the Elders who administer the Congregational Care Fund will confidentially process it.

The following form must be completed by July 15 for the first Rockway billing to include grant information. Forms should be submitted to the church treasurer (treasurer@erbstchurch.ca). If enrollment plans change, please contact the church as soon as possible.
